Guidelines for Anonymous Embryo Donation

Thank you for your interest in the embryo donation program. The following is an outline of the requirements for embryo donors. We hope to make the completion of these requirements as effortless as possible.

Step 1: Complete the Embryo Disposition form

Step 2: Call the clinic to schedule the following appointments:

- Schedule appointment with Office Manager Angie Ipsen (notary) to complete the ICRM Embryo Donation Consent for Donors. (consent will be provided at office)
- Schedule appointment with ICRM lab for infectious disease screening (all screening fees are covered by ICRM)

Step 3: Pick up Profile forms and FDA donor screening questionnaire, complete these forms and return to clinic

If you are unable or unwilling to complete the above requirements, but are still interested in embryo donation, please contact our office. We are always available to help you with any questions or concerns you may have regarding the embryo donation process. Again, thank you for your interest in the embryo donation program at ICRM.

If your embryos have not been selected for transfer after a five year period, the likelihood they will be chosen is small. Therefore, after five years the embryos will become the property of ICRM and their disposition will be at the discretion of your physician.
